HOSPITAL EQUIPMENT

With your help, we have equipped 28 hospitals in 9 regions of Ukraine (Odesa, Kharkiv, Dnipro, Novomoskovsk (Dnipropetrovsk region), Kyiv, Khmelnytskyi, Mykolaiv, Lviv, Kurakhiv (Donetska region) and Sumy) with lifesaving medical equipment and accessories.

AMBULANCE



in July, we handed over **10 ambulances** to hospitals and doctors working in active combat zones.

In Kyiv, we met with representatives of the Commander of Medical Services of Armed Forces of Ukraine and six medical brigades.

Ambulances were filled with all the necessary equipment.

Each ambulance is equipped with:

- **356 items - medical bags**
- **AEDs**
- **Monitors**
- **Portable suction and not to forget CAT tourniquets and Israeli bandages**

These cars will help to evacuate and treat the wounded from the red zone and transfer them to the hospitals

Also, in July, Iryna Rybinkina and her team delivered **2 ambulances to Donetsk and Dnipropetrovsk regions**. They are especially needed there, because the russians are constantly shelling these territories. Fierce fighting continues in Donetsk region. The availability of ambulances and the necessary equipment is an opportunity to save hundreds of lives.

BLS (Basic Life Support) skills are now extremely important for Ukrainians. therefore, we continue to teach them and hold free courses for everyone.

1 for teachers of the Institute of Postgraduate Pedagogical Education


